

Progressive Volunteer Award Application



The Progressive Volunteer Award(s) are for an adult who is involved in Girl Scouts on a continual basis, rather than an episodic basis, at the council or national level. Six different awards may be presented at this level. They include:

1. **Volunteer Development Pin** - awarded for volunteer's completion of successful initial service on a board committee or task group assignment and has agreed to return for the following year.
2. **The Girl Scout Mentoring Award (White Key)** - earned when a volunteer who has become a mentor or coach for another volunteer.
3. **The Girl Scout Volunteer Executive Award (Black Key)** - earned when a volunteer has provide leadership at the council or national level.
4. **The Girl Scout Volunteer Diversity Award (Gold Key)** - earned when a volunteer has increased membership in underrepresented populations, or increase awareness and understanding through enrichment events or training.
5. **The Girl Scout Community Cultivation Award (Silver Key)** - earned when a volunteer has increased membership by using the talents and skills of all the dimensions of difference.
6. **The Girl Scout Fund Development Award (Copper Key)** - earned when the volunteer has helped to reach the council's fund development goal.

The Volunteer Development Pin must be earned before any of the keys are earned.
